

Tiered Garland Halloween Countdown

Supplies you will need:

- 7 Pieces of Coordinating 12X12 Cardstock
- Patterned Paper for decorating (We used Bo Bunny's new Halloween line)
- Tags to put in some pockets (we used Bo Bunny)
- Chipboard Stickers (We used Bo Bunny's new 12X12) or other elements for decorating
- Ribbon for decorating
- String or ribbon to hang pockets from
- Printed numbers
- Hole punch to punch holes in tops of pockets
- Stapler
- Adhesive
- Ink for distressing edges if desired.

Instructions:

1. Cut each piece of cardstock using the diagram provided. (you should get 5 strips from each piece of cardstock)
2. Fold each cardstock strip to make a hinge. You can fold all of your pieces at different heights to create levels in your garland.
3. Place two staples in each edge of the fold so that you create a pocket.
4. Decorate each pocket as desired with ribbon, stickers, patterned paper.
5. Cut out numbers from print out and add to each pocket in numerical order.
6. Punch holes in the top corners of each pocket and thread the pockets onto the garland as desired (you may need to play around with the order you hang them in so that it flows right).
7. Fill each pocket with a treat or activity to do.
